A RESOLUTION INCREASING APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY POLICE TRAILERS BY \$20,000 TO A TOTAL OF \$55,000

WHEREAS, at its September 8, 2021, meeting, the Township Committee authorized the leasing of two trailers from Will Scott for use by the police department during the time that police headquarters could not be used because of damage resulting from Hurricane Ida at a cost of \$35,000; and

WHEREAS, repairs to police headquarters are ongoing and, as a result, the police department needs the trailers for an additional period of time; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, as the person responsible for determining and confirming the existence of an emergency and that the provisions for emergency purchasing pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6* may be implemented, has determined that the emergency which necessitated the leasing of these trailers has not ended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey that

- 1. The amount appropriated for the trailers being used by the police department is hereby increased from \$35,000 to \$55,000 and the leases are hereby extended.
- 2. This contract shall be charged to budget line item(s) T-12-0278-00999-6-00000. The certification of available funds by the Financial Officer shall be attached to the original of this resolution and shall be maintained in the files of the Township Clerk.
