## AUTHORIZING SALE AT PUBLIC ACTION OF REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE TOWNSHIP LOCATED AT 80 WESTERN BOULEVARD, GILLETTE

**WHEREAS,** Estelle K. Wilhelm, formerly of Gillette, died testate in Morris County, New Jersey on September 28, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Wilhelm, in her Last Will and Testament dated February 14, 2006 devised her property located at 80 Western Boulevard, Gillette to the Township of Long Hill without restriction or qualification; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee, by the adoption of Ordinance #31313 on October 9, 2013, accepted the devise of Ms. Wilhelm's property; and

**WHEREAS,** the property, which contains a single-family residence, is not needed for public use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Lands and Buildings Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13 provides that "a municipality may sell any real property not needed for public use as set forth in the resolution or ordinance authorizing the sale" and by following the procedures set forth in the statute;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

- The sale of the real property owned by the Township located at 80 Western Boulevard, Gillette is hereby authorized by open public sale at auction to the highest bidder.
- The above property shall be advertised for public sale pursuant to all requirements and procedures set forth in the Local Lands and Buildings Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq.).
- 3. The Township Clerk shall advertise notice of the sale in a newspaper circulating in the Township by two insertions at least once a week during two consecutive weeks, the last publication to be not earlier than seven (7) days prior to such sale.
- 4. Bids shall be received by the Township Clerk on the **14**<sup>th</sup> **day of March, 2014**, at **10:00 AM** at the Town Hall, 915 Valley Road, Gillette, New Jersey, in the manner of a public auction in accordance with procedures to be announced by the Township Clerk.
- 5. The Township will not accept a bid of less than **\$195,000.00**. All bids shall be referred to the Township Committee for review and final approval pursuant to

N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13a. The Township reserves the right to accept the highest bid or to reject any and all bids, including the highest bid, and shall make its decision known by resolution within ten (10) days after bids are received.

- 6. Bidders shall make payment as follows:
  - a. Cash or certified check within fifteen minutes of the close of bidding, 10% of bid price.
  - b. Cash or certified check at a closing to be held on or before **April 11, 2014**; 90% of purchase price.
- 7. Within 15 minutes of the close of bidding the highest qualified bidder, as designated by the Township Clerk, shall submit cash or certified check in the amount of 10% of its bid and shall immediately execute an offer to purchase at its bid price, which offer shall include the terms and conditions specified herein.
  - 8. Title shall be conveyed by Bargain and Sale Deed.
- 9. At closing of title, purchaser shall submit an additional sum of money equal to the costs of all advertising of the sale and the recording of the Township's deed.
- 10. The property shall be used only for single-family residential purposes in compliance with the Township land use ordinances.
- 11. Failure to comply with any of the above requirements or to close on or before **April 11, 2014,** shall entitle the Township to rescind prior bid approval, terminate any and all rights of the designated bidder in said property and retain all monies theretofore deposited.
- 12. The property is being conveyed subject to existing encumbrances, liens, zoning regulations, easements, other restrictions, such facts as an accurate survey would reveal and any present or future assessments for the construction of improvements benefitting said property.
- The Township will not pay any realtor commission in connection with the sale.
