WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1.2 defines "sewer extension" to mean "any sewer pipe, line, structure or appurtenance used for the conveyance of domestic or industrial waste of a liquid nature, whether forced or by gravity, which: 1. Will extend along an easement through more than two properties, a roadway, or public right-of-way. . . . "; and

WHEREAS, in order for Mr. Bontempo to connect he must cross the property of Mr. & Mrs. Fullerton of 404 Meyersville Road who have consented by letter dated February 19, 2015 to an easement which will allow Mr. Bontempo to connect.

WHEREAS, the Township has adopted by reference the NJDEP sewer ban exemption criteria set forth in N.J.A.C. 7:14A-22.22; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 7:14A-22.22 provides in relevant part that:

"A sewer ban exemption may be granted for projects . . . if the proposed project will have a total projected flow of 600 gallons per day or less . . . [and] will be constructed and/or operated on a tax lot which was in existence prior to the effective date of the ban . . . and the proposed project does not require a sewer extension"; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C 7:14A-23.3 provides that:

(c) The Department recognizes that the table in (a) above may not cover all establishments and facilities, and in particular facilities that require an industrial treatment works approval. In the event that a facility is not covered, the applicant shall propose the projected flow based upon operation of similar facilities or best professional judgment. The Department reserves the right to accept, modify or deny the proposed flow values. . . . "; and

WHEREAS, James Pontoriero, Supervisor, Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Environmental, Engineering and Permitting, IN A May 25, 2016 email advised the Applicant's attorney that:

"The Township has the discretion to accept projected wastewater flows based upon a similar type of facility since this type of use is not in the regulations under NJAC 7:14A-23.3. Please be advised that this project doesn't appear to require a TWA..."; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed the data submitted by the Applicant and determined that the proposed project will have an average daily flow of less than 600 gallons per day; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Goddard School is therefore entitled to an exemption from the sewer ban pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14A-22.22;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that the Goddard School is hereby granted permission to connect the newly constructed property at Block 10601, Lot 3 to the Township wastewater treatment system upon payment of the \$10,120.00 connection fee in accordance with Section 22-3.1 of the Township Code.

ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE PUBLIC HEARING/CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION

ORDINANCE # 388 -16 AIR PERMITS AND AMENDING CHAPTER

CONCERNING SOCIAL AFFAIR PERMITS AND AMENDING CHAPTER VI OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL"

WHEREAS, the applicable Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) regulation provides that applications for social affair permits are to be submitted directly to the Division (*N.J.A.C.* 13:2-5.1); and

WHEREAS, the Township's only involvement in the application process is that both the Chief of Police and the Township Clerk must endorse the application; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-7 of the Township Code entitled "Social Affair Permit" is inconsistent with the provisions of the ABC regulation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that Chapter VI of the Township Code entitled "Alcoholic Beverage Control" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 6-7 entitled "Social Affair Permit" is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"6-7 SOCIAL AFFAIR PERMIT.

The New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control regulations allow an organization operating solely for civic, religious, educational, charitable, fraternal, social or recreational purposes, and not for private gain, to apply for a special permit to serve alcoholic beverages at a fund-raising event. No more than twelve (12) such daily permits may be issued to any one (1) organization in a calendar year and no more than twenty five (25) permits may be issued for any one (1) premises or location in a calendar year. Applications for special permits for social affairs which must be submitted on the application form provided by the New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control require the approval of the Township Committee and the endorsement of the Township Clerk and the Township Chief of Police. In order to allow the Township Police Department adequate time to conduct the required background investigations, all such applications must be submitted to the Township Clerk at least eight (8) weeks prior to the first event covered by the proposed social affair permit. The Chief of Police or his designee is authorized to obtain criminal history record information background checks for noncriminal purposes in accordance with N.J.A.C. 13:59 1.1 to 1.6 on all persons required to be named on the application. The applicant shall be required to submit with its application the full amount of the fees the Township will have to remit to the State Bureau of Investigation to process these criminal history record information background checks.

Any qualified civic, religious, educational, charitable, fraternal, social, or recreational nonprofit organization that wishes to serve alcoholic beverages at a social affair must first obtain a special permit directly from the Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control in accordance with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 13:2-5.1, and all other applicable, statutes, ordinances and regulations. That application which is submitted to the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control must be endorsed by the Township Clerk and the Chief of Police."

- **Section 2.** Any and all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.
 - **Section 3.** In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in

any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
