

**TOWNSHIP OF LONG HILL  
CAPITAL ORDINANCE #431-19**

***Statement of Purpose***

*Capital Ordinance of the Township of Long Hill, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey authorizing acquisitions in, by and for the Township and appropriating therefore the sum of \$98,029.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund.*

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows;

**Section 1.** The Township of Long Hill, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey (the “Township”), is hereby authorized to make the following public acquisition in, by and for the Township, including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefore:

<u><b>PURPOSE</b></u>	<u><b>ESTIMATED COSTS</b></u>
<b>Police in car and Body Cameras</b>	<b>\$98,029.00</b>

**Section 2.** The aggregate sum of \$98,029.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township to the payment of the costs of acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof.

**Section 3.** Said acquisition are lawful capital improvements of the Township having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements and acquisitions shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

**Section 4.** The capital ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

The foregoing ordinance having been introduced and passed on first reading by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill, in the County of Morris on Wednesday, February 13, 2019 will be considered for final passage and adoption at a public hearing held at a meeting beginning at 7:30 p.m. on **Wednesday, February 27, 2019** at the Municipal Building, 915 Valley Road, Gillette, New Jersey when and where or at such time and place to which said meeting may be adjourned, all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning said ordinance.
